GET RID OF YOUR ANTI-FREEZE, BATTERIES, OIL, PAINT, TIRES, SENSITIVE PAPERWORK THAT NEEDS TO BE SHREDDED, METAL ITEMS, AND LEAVES & BRUSH @ Northland Neighborhoods, Inc. “A.B.O.P.T.” event. This will be in the east parking lot of Antioch Mall on Saturday, May 2nd from 8:00 a.m. - noon. They will not accept trash.

GET RID OF YOUR LEAVES & BRUSH during the KC, MO curbside brush pick up on Friday, May 8th. See details on back page of newsletter. Also, you can drop off leaves and brush at the drop-off site at 1815 N Chouteau Trafficway on Saturdays from 8:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m.

GET RID OF EXPIRED OR UNUSED MEDICINE at the KC, MO Hazardous Waste Facility at 4707 Deramus. You must call 784-2080 ahead for an appointment! (Without an appointment, they may not be able to unload your items. If they can, they’ll charge you a drive up fee of \$10.) They are open 9:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. Thursday, Friday and Saturday.

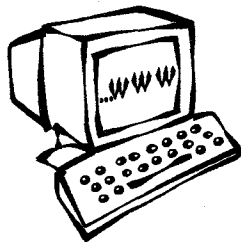

Metal disposal

Advantage Metal will provide a metal recycling bin to safely dispose of the following metal items: steel, iron, & aluminum items; old metal bikes and toys; structural beams; electric motors; radiators; stainless steel and rebar.

Paper shredding

Shred-It Mobil shredding truck will be onsite to securely shred your confidential documents. They will accept all types of paper along with staples, paperclips, three ring binders, spiral notebooks, and most office materials. You will be able to witness your materials being destroyed.

Other (A.B.O.P.T.)

Anti-freeze; car & household batteries; oil (automotive, cooking, heating, etc.); paints & paint related chemicals such as strippers, thinners, varnishes, & spray paints; and tires.

Leaves & brush - paper bags only; no plastic!

Curbside Brush Pickup

- Friday, May 8th
- Needs to be curbside no later than 7:00 a.m.
- 20 sacks &/or bundle limit
- Paper sacks only; no plastic bags
- Bundled brush can be no larger than 4'X2' and bundled with twine only
- No duct tape
- If brush hasn't been picked up by Saturday, call the Action Center at 3-1-1 or 513-1313.
