From the Board...

We have two topics to discuss with our members in this newsletter...

The first topic is when, and just as important, when <u>not</u> to call Knight Watchman Security.

Knight Watchman provides patrolling services for all areas covered within the Longview Lake Association. This includes all homes, duplexes, and Willowbend apartments, along with the parks and pools. The purpose of the patrols is to <u>discourage</u> crimes such as loitering, burglary, vandalism, and auto theft.

What Knight Watchman does <u>not</u> provide is police services like responding to matters such as fights, intruders, and other emergency situations. For these matters, you need to call 911.

Here's a few samples of when to call Knight Watchman:

- Going on vacation—the patrol will keep an eye out for your property.
- After-the-fact burglary and vandalism—report these crimes to the police first, but also report them to Knight Watchman. This will allow the patrol to step up their efforts in your area.
- Suspicious persons—again, call the police first, but also call Knight Watchman.
