- Opening with Pledge of Allegiance by Sue Feldman at 7:00pm
- Motion made by Mark to move agenda topics around. 1st Betty, 2nd Pauline
- Fire Report– Lt Poole. 8 Fire responses, 1 non-fire response, 31 EMS runs
- Police Report– Officer Ventre. 95 Assault and Menacing, 19 Drug, 252 Noise and Nuisance, 1 Official Assistance, 2 other and 53 Weapons. Totaling 422. This total from last year was only 383. Calls are up 10.18% from last year.
- Treasurer's Report– Deposit from NSP-\$2,807.50, Deposit anonymous donation-\$250.00, Deposit Membership Dues-\$36.00, Adamson Construction-Installing Banners-\$775.00, Nature Landscape Traffic Island-\$1,100, Nature Landscape Gateway-\$200.00, Home Depot Gift Cards-\$150.00, USA Flags-\$115.01, Chris Reynolds-Light at Memorial-\$200.00, FedEx-Printing April Newsletter-\$103.74, McCabe Stamps for April Newsletter-\$126.00, Kim Stenger Typing April Newsletter-\$50.00, Betty Cook for cleanup-\$50.00, Fedex Office-\$128.49. Balance brought forward \$1,052.01 First by Betty, 2nd by Matt. Motion carried.
- Historic Committee—Diego Jordan began the design layout for the historical signs
- Building Committee– 723 Delhi and 702 Sedam will be going to court. 711 Steiner was served notice. 735 Sedam was the house of the month.
- NSP projects– Money was received
- Clean up - Was a great success!!
- UC Research: Three students from UC school of design wrote a paper about Sedamsville and presented a copy for the community. We have permission to copy it and it is interesting with history, demographics. If interested, a copy can be provided.
- Visitors: CRC Representatives were in attendance at this meeting. Ideas were discussed with the representatives of what can be done with Boldface Park. Suggestions were: **SAFETY:** Safety bollards at River Road play area, Replace fence on field house with continuous railing at 42" high, Additional Lighting behind field house, Cameras. **MAINTENANCE:** Give deadline for repair of existing restrooms. Porta-lets should not be permanent. Basketball hoops and nets replaced or repaired, repaint court lines, Repair spalling concrete on field house ceiling, Repair drinking fountain, Program activities. **IMPROVEMENTS:** Multi-Use Pad—100'x42' concrete pad with built in, Consolidate play equipment to southwest corner of park and install aquatic feature in place of the northern play equipment, Parking area in recently acquired lots—clear and resurface, Allow for volleyball on existing basketball court.
- Other: Cincinnati Soap Box Derby (The Mayor's Cup) is set for June 27th and 28th. Sedamsville Civic Association is sponsoring a derby car for this event. Let's wish them luck.
- Paula Brehm-Heeger, Library Services Manager-Central from the Public Library of Cincinnati and Hamilton County will be a guest speaker at our **June** meeting.
