Recipe of the month

Fruit Cocktail Cake

2 cups flour
2 eggs
1 can fruit cocktail

1 ½ cups sugar
2 tsps. baking soda

Icing

1 can coconut
¾ cup sugar
(Pecans optional)

1 stick oleo
1 small can of cream

Mix fruit cocktail with mixer; add sifted flour, sugar, baking soda and eggs. While cake is baking, cook icing on stove.

Pour over top of cake while hot.

Bake at 350 degrees for 30 or 40 minutes in a greased 13x9 pan or until cake tests done.
