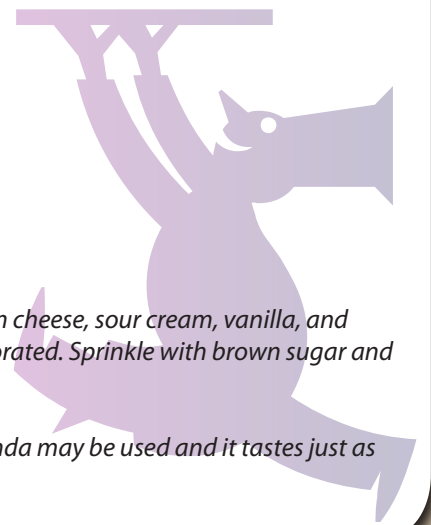
Recipe of the Month Grape Salad

4 pounds of seedless grapes (green or purple)
1 8-ounce package of cream cheese *
1 8-ounce container sour cream *
1/2 cup white sugar *
1 teaspoon vanilla extract
4 ounces chopped pecans
2 tablespoons brown sugar

Wash and dry grapes. In a large bowl, combine cream cheese, sour cream, vanilla, and white sugar. Add grapes and mix until evenly incorporated. Sprinkle with brown sugar and pecans, mix again and refrigerate until serving.
