Recipe of the Month

From the kitchen of
Barbara O'Mary

20 Minute Minestrone

- 5 cups fat-free beef, chicken or vegetable broth
- 1 can (14-1/2oz.) diced tomatoes
- 1 can (8oz.) tomato sauce
- 1 teaspoon dried, crushed basil
- 1 teaspoon dried, crushed thyme
- 1/4 teaspoon black pepper
- 1 teaspoon sugar (optional)
- 1 cup pasta (spirals or elbow macaroni), uncooked
- 2 cups frozen mixed vegetables
- 1 can (15-1/2 oz) white kidney beans
- 1 teaspoon grated Parmesan cheese (optional)

In a large kettle or saucepan, combine broth, tomatoes, tomato sauce, herbs, pepper, and sugar (if used) Bring to a boil. Add the remaining ingredients. Simmer uncovered until the pasta and the vegetables are cooked, about 15 to 20 minutes. Serve in soup bowls with a sprinkle of Parmesan cheese for accent and taste.
