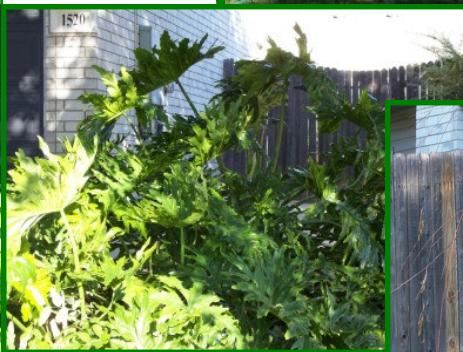

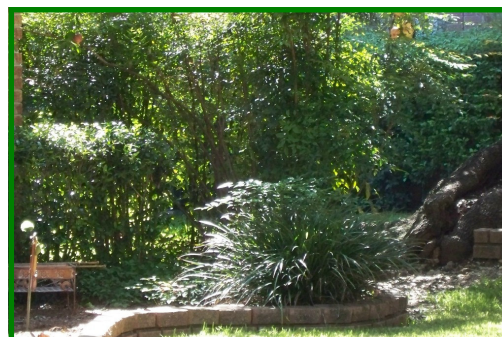
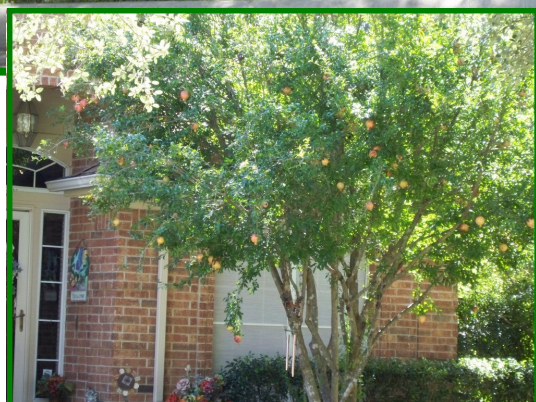
1520 Jasmine Drive—Yard of the Month
