Residents urged to get Flu Shots

The novel H1N1 Influenza A virus that emerged in the spring is still causing illness in our community. The Metro Health Department encourages residents to get both the seasonal flu and H1N1 v a c c i n a t i o n s.

The novel H1N1 virus is easily spread, especially among those five to 24 years old. That means the virus is spreading extensively in schools, creating illness that will eventually lead home and to work.

There are some things you can do to slow the spread of the flu virus.

Get the seasonal flu vaccination, which targets the other flu strains (not novel H1N1) expected to be circulating during the normal months of October to March, and possibly through May.

Cover your nose and mouth with a tissue or the inside of your elbow when you cough or sneeze. Throw the tissue in the trash after you use it.
