This family event is free and open to the public. For



Night Out in San Antonio ranks 2nd in the nation

Congratulations San Antonio residents! Once again, your participation has led to San Antonio being awarded second place in the nation under Category 1 for National Night Out (NNO) 2009. San Antonio was ranked the highest out of the six Texas cities listed in the category.

This years event involved 36.7 million people in 14,625 communities from all 50 states, U.S. territories and military bases world wide. Texas was also selected as first place winner in the category 9 level (State).

During NNO, neighborhoods join together at block parties or specialized social events to heighten drug and crime prevention awareness; generate support for and participate in local anticrime programs; strengthen neighborhood spirit and police-community; and send a strong message to criminals letting them know that their neighborhood along with millions of others are fighting back.

This year, the JNA joined forces with the Monticello Park Neighborhood Association to help produce the outstanding ranking the city received.
