resident's Notes **By Rich Taylor**

While I am always reluctant to open any communication with bad news. I want to get your attention right up front. As much as we would like to believe that we live in a safe community filled with law abiding citizens, recent events challenge those beliefs. At our last Cellular On Patrol (COP) meeting we reviewed reports of at least four burglaries in various parts of El Dorado. Unfortunately, some of the burglars were not deterred because the residents had not adequately secured their homes, even when some of the homes had security devices.

Be sure you have adequate locks and other security features on your home. And be sure you use those locks and security features as they are intended!

At least one of the burglaries took place during daylight hours with the suspicion that the intruders may have been residents of the area and thus possibly familiar with the schedules of the residents. Please do what you need to do to keep your home and possessions secure. Also, help your neighbors by watching for any unusual activity around yours and your neighbor's homes. If you see anything suspicious, do what you can to get a description of the suspect(s) and notify the police right away.

These disturbing new reports emphasize the need for more residents to help their neighbors by becoming involved in the COP program. If you and other concerned citizens get involved in COP and give an hour or so each week in patrolling the neighborhood your visibility will make a big difference. Each potential COP member must attend a one-time, four hour training session at the Police North Substation at 13030 Maltsberger before you can participate in a patrol. To get a schedule of upcoming classes and reserve a space, call Officer J. Dave McDonald at 207-6086.

On another subject of concern to many residents, do vou contribute to the clutter and show lack of care for the community by leaving your UGLY TRASHCANS in plain view? Please show more interest in the appearance of your area and consideration for your neighbors by taking a few minutes to store those **UGLY CANS** out of sight as soon as possible after they are emptied.



1 1/2 C coarsely 3 dozen Ritz crackers

grated cheese

Beat eggs and mix with milk and liquid drained from can of asparagus. Add salt. Place layer of crackers in bottom of medium size baking dish, follow with layer of asparagus, layer of cheese and portion of the oleo. Repeat layers. Pour milk and egg mixture over layers, cover with crackers, sprinkle top with paprika. Bake at 375 for 15-20 minutes or until mixture thickens and top is brown. Serves 6.



U.S. 2010 Census in San Antonio

Soon, the United States Census Bureau will mail more than 600,000 Census forms to households across San Antonio and Bexar County. To ensure valuable community services and a better quality of life for our community in the upcoming 10 years, the City of San Antonio and Bexar County want to ensure that everyone living in our area is counted.

Your participation in the 2010 Census will ensure that a portion of the \$400 billion in federal funding will go directly to local community programs, healthcare, schools, and infrastructure. In addition, an accurate count the population assures political representation at all levels of government. Collected census information is not shared with anyone, including the Internal Revenue Immigration Service, and Custom Enforcement, Federal Bureau of Investigation, Central Intelligence Agency, or any other governmental agency. There are no exceptions.

Plastic grocery bags not accepted in City's curbside recycling program



The City's Solid Waste Management Department (SWMD) wants to remind San Antonio residents that plastic grocery bags <u>are not</u> accepted in the City's curbside recycling program.

Plastic grocery bags are lightweight and are prone to getting tangled in recycling equipment and conveyor belts. They can also contaminate items causing them to be rejected.

However, if you want to recycle your plastic grocery bags, SWMD encourages residents to take them to their local grocery store that has containers to collect and recycle plastic bags.

At home, residents should place recyclable items directly in the blue cart. No bags are needed for recyclable items. If you are using plastic grocery bags to separate your recyclables from your trash, please remember to remove the items from the plastic bag before throwing in your blue cart.

Bags should only be placed in your brown cart. If you forget just remember bag in brown, recycle in blue, it's easy to do.

So remember, no bags in your blue cart, just rinse and throw your recyclables right in.
