

The Somali Community is a Promising Economic Powerhouse In Ohio

On July 1, 2009, the Governor of the State of Ohio, and members of the House, in recognition of the contributions of the Somali community to the state, honored the Independence Day of Somalia by raising the Somali flag at the Ohio State House along with the US and Ohio State flags. This was a welcome gesture from legislators and the state leadership for the enterprising Somali community, the newest Americans in Ohio.

There are more than 45,000 Somali Americans in Central Ohio according to the Somali Community Access Network, a community based nonprofit that provides services and resources to the Somali community in Ohio. The majority of these Somali Americans live in Franklin County which includes the City of Columbus.

The State of Ohio has the second largest Somali population in the US after Minnesota. However, Columbus has the largest concentration of Somalis in any US city. Somalis started coming to Columbus in the early 1990s after the central government in Somalia was overthrown by armed warlords who led the country into chaos. Since then, Columbus became a favorite destination for Somalis from Africa as well as secondary immigrants from other states.

In a 2005 report, the Community Research Partners found that Franklin County foreign born population has grown from 32,235 in 1990 to 84,854 in 2003. The study predicted that foreign born residents will make up 12% of the county population by 2010. A huge proportion of this growth is accounted for by Somali immigrants who become residents through the US refugee Resettlement Program.

The Somali Community in Ohio contributes to the local economy in various ways:

1. Economic Contribution:

Columbus Ohio has more than 400 Somali owned businesses. The businesses vary in size, revenue, and the number of employees. Here is a synopsis of some types of businesses:

Waxaa bartamaha Ohio jooga in ka badan 45,000 oo Soomaali Maraykan ah ah sida ay bidhaaminayo Somali Community Access Network, urur bulshadu ay sal u tahay oo aan faa'iido doon ahayn oo u adeega umadda Soomaalida ah ee Ohio. Inta badan dadkaas Soomaalida uhu waxay ku nool yihiin degmada Franklin oo ay ku jirto caasimadda oo Columbus ah.

Gobolka Ohio waxaa ku nool Soomaalida kaalinta labaad ee dalka Maraykanka. Waxaa ka horreeya oo keliya Minnesota. Laakiin Columbus waa degmo ahaan midda ugu dad Soomaaliyeed badan ee qaranka Maraykanka. Soomaalidu waxay billowday in ay timaaddo carradan Columbus billowgii 1990aadkii oo ku beegnayd markii ay qabqablayaal dirireed oo isbahaystay udbaha u dhiljiyeen dawladdii dhexe ee Soomaaliya ka talinaysay kuwaas oo qalaanqal ku dhex tuuray Soomaaliya iyo Soomaalidaba. **Eeg Bogga 2**

Other types of businesses include: cleaning companies, track/transportation companies, travel agencies, cab companies, auto sales dealerships, auto service shops, home healthcare agencies, retailers, barber shops, communications dealers, employment service agencies, money transfer and check cashing, gold dealers, charter schools, and nonprofit community support groups.

Somalis buy goods and services from local businesses to the tune of hundreds of millions of dollars annually. They buy properties, cars, trucks, businesses and other commodities.

All these businesses and individual employees pay federal, state and local taxes on their incomes and on the commodities they purchase. How do Somalis get all the money for starting these businesses you may ask! Somalis use an effective method of wealth accumulation which is compatible with their faith and culture. According to their Islamic faith, it is not allowed to charge or pay interest on money. If they borrow money, they are expected to pay back the same amount without incurring any interest. This facilitates investment and creation of new businesses.

Money is usually borrowed from friends or raised in a Somali system that pools resources together known as "Ayuuto" or "Shaloongo" where a number of people, usually 10-15, save a portion of their incomes every month or every pay period. For example, each of the 15 individuals saves \$500 total amount becomes \$7,500 which is given to one person who is ready to start business or invest the money. The process goes on for 15 months until everyone of the group gets paid \$7,500. If this group wants to start a business together, they can raise \$112,500 in fifteen months to start a business!

2. Professional Contribution:

There are Somali doctors, nurses, lawyers, economists, engineers, architects, computer professionals, teachers, and entrepreneurs. Columbus is home for the leading minds of Somalia including the family of Somalia's longest serving president, cabinet ministers, state governors, ambassadors/diplomats, professors, business tycoons and civil service employees. These people transfer knowledge and skills and inject it into the local economy.

Somalis are very hardworking and industrious people. Most young men and women work more than one job, run or co-own businesses and go to school! All this is positive for the economy.

3. Cultural Diversity

The man who composed the Somali National Anthem, Ali Mire Awale, lives in Columbus! Every Somali knows the song "Soomaaliyeey Toosoo"! Sahra Dawo is a household name in Somalia and her songs are widely broadcast in Somali media and listened to by millions of Somalis. She is available in Columbus, Ohio to provide entertainment to crowds and at events such as weddings and festivals. Abdulkadir Hirsip Yamyam, one of the greatest Somali poets and writers of all time is buried in Columbus! The community added a sense of diversity to the entertainment industry. There are five Somali studios in Columbus.

Columbus is home to the Somali Documentary Project, a program that intends to capture the history of Somalia and specially the lives of Somalis in the Diaspora through photography. The project team is an example of diversity: Abdi Roble and Tariq Tarey, two Somali photographers, joined hands with Dr. Doug Rutledge, who holds a PhD in Cultural Anthropology. The project has produced its first book "the Somali Diaspora: A Journey Away" containing the words of Dr. Rutledge and photographs by Abdi Roble.

Olol Studio, a renowned producer of Somali films is also located in Ohio. Some of the bilingual movies written, directed and produced in Columbus include: Araweelo, Ambad, and Rajo. *Continued on: Page 3*

Wixii berigaa ka dambeeyey Columbus waxay noqotay meel ay aad u jecel yihiin imashaadeeda Soomaalida ka imanaysay Afrika iyo kuwo meelo kaleeto ka soo hayaamayeyba.

Xog ay diyaarisay 2005ti Community Research Partners ayaa lagu ogaadey in dadka reer degmada Franklin ah oo shisheeyaha u dhashay markoodii hore ay ka siyaadeen 32,235 oo ay ahaayeeyen 1990 ilaa iyo 84,854 oo ay gaaren 2003. Xogtaas ayaa saadaalisay in dadka ku dhashay dalalka qalaad ee meeshan u nasab sheegtay ay u dhigmi doonaan 12% oo dadka degmada ah marka la gaaro 2010. In baaxad leh oo ka mid ah kororkaas ayaa waxaa keenay Soomaalidii ku soo degaysay Barnaamija Marayanka ee Dibudejinta.

Jaaliyadda Soomaaliyeed ee Ohio siyaabo badan bay wax ugu kordhisaa dhaqaalaha maxalliga ah ee halkan:

1. Ku biirin dhaqaale:

Columbus Ohio waxaa ku yaal in ka badan 400 oo meheradood oo ay Soomaalidu leedahay. Waa ay kala xajmi iyo dakhli badan yihiin meheraadku iyo shaqaaleba. Hoos ka eeg jeebis gudub ku saabsan qaar ka mid ah meheradahaas:

Moolal: Global Mall, Jubba Mall, West Site Mall, Banadir Mall, Westland Mall, Universal Marketplace, Aaran Discount Market iyo kuwo kale.

Maqaayaadka: African Paradise, Banadir Cuisine, Cananley, Darbo Restaurant, Iftin Restaurant, Bilan Restaurant, Calanley Restaurant, Banadir Restaurant Capital Café, Safari Café iyo kuwo kale.

Noocyada kale ee meheradaha waxaa ka mid ah shirkado nadiifineed kuwo taraagyada, meelo safarrada, tagaasileey, dhiillarro gaadiidka iibsha kuwo gada baabbuurta, kuwa dadka liita guryaha ku xannaanneeyas, timojareyaal, dheellarro isgaarsiinta, ajensiyo shaqaalayneed, xawaalado dahableyaal iskuullo gaar ah, iyo ururro aan dawli ahayn oo dadka u adeega.

Malaayiin dollar ayay Soomaalidu cuntooyin iyo adeegyo kaleba siisataa sanadkii. Waxay iibsadaan hanti ma-guурto ah gaadiid kala jaad ah meherado iyo agabyo kale. Dhamaan meheradahaas iyo dadka shaqeeyaba waxay bixiyaan canshuuraha noocyadooda kala duwan oo ay ka bixiyaan dakghliyadooda iyo waxyabaha ay iibsanyaanba.

Haddii aad is weydiinaysid sida ay Soomaalidu ku hesho xoolahan oo dhan, waxaad ogaan kartaa markaad u dhabbo gashid in Soomaalidu ay leeyihiin nidaam beeso uruursi oo la saanqaadi kara iimaankooda iyo dhaqankooda. Diintooda Islaamka ayaan oggolayn in haddii uu qofku deynsado qaddar beeso ah ama alaab aan la saari karayn wax masaaliixad ah oo dheeraad ah oo aan ahayn wuxuu deyntay. Tan ayaa sahasha maalgashiga iyo abuuritaannada meherado cusub. Ayuuto ama Shaloongo ayaa laysku daraa oo ay dadku midba mar siyaan beesadooda. Tanina waa marka ay koox dad uhu oo 10 – 15 ahayn waxa ka kaydiyaan beesadooda soo gashay oo tusaale ahaan inta ay 15 qof midkiiba kaydiso \$500 ayaa hal qof ah la siyyaa markaasuu qofkaasi wuxuu helaa \$7,500. Mar kastana ama bil kastaba si wareegto ah ayay 15ti qof u qaataan beesadii shaloongada ahayd. Haddii ay kooxdani doonto in ay billaabato meherad cusub waxay aruuriin karayaan \$112,500 shan iyo tobantillood gudhood!

2. Ku biirinta Xirfadlennimada:

Waxaa jooga dhakhaatiir kalkaaliyeaal, garyaqaaanno, dhaqaaleyahanno, injiyeerro, naqshadeeyeyaa, kuwo ku xoogsada kumbiyutarrada, macallimiin iyo garab-ku-ruxato. Columbus waxaa jooga dad badan oo Soomaalida micne badan ku dhex leh oo uu ku jiro qoyskii madaxweynihii ugu waqtii dheeraa ee Soomaaliya, golihii wusarada, guddoomiyeeyashii gobollada, danjireyaasha iyo dublumaasiyiinta, barayaasha jaamicadaha, ganacsadeyaal tujaar ah iyo shaqaalihii qaranka. Dadkani waxay soo meeriyaaan aqoon iyo xirfad ay ku biiriyaan dhaqaalaha maxalliga ah. *Eeg Bogga: 3aad*

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Political Contribution:

David Robinson, the Democratic Candidate for the 12th Congressional seat who received substantial support from Somalis in 2008 had told NPR “It’s an important number of votes. We figure there’s probably going to be somewhere between 350,000 and 400,000 votes cast totally for the 12th Congressional Seat, so 10,000 votes or so is an important constituency”. Robinson had won the Franklin County vote by more than 10,000 votes but he lost Delaware and Licking counties by a wide margin.

W. Carlton Weddington, the 27th District Representative in the Ohio House of Representatives, who successfully campaigned in the Somali community last year recognizes the size and the political influence of this community. Weddington was responsible for the raising of the Somali flag at Ohio State House to commemorate the 49th anniversary of Somali independence.

In the 2008 US elections, the Somali community had actively participated in the process for the first time. The National Public Radio published a story entitled “Columbus Somalis Gain Citizenship, Head for Polls”.

To be able to contribute to the economic and social development of the state, more than 3000 Somali students are enrolled in institutions of higher education in pursuit of Associates, Bachelor's, Masters and Doctoral degrees. A professor at Franklin University told SomaliCAN Outreach Newsletter recently: “I can’t recall the last time I taught a graduate or an undergraduate class that didn’t have any Somalis”.

The Somali community is a powerhouse in regards to its economic impact of the Midwest. The economic and political clout that the community wields is expected to increase in the next decade. It is the community to watch as it transitions from seeking help to giving hope and help to millions of Americans.

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County Boards of MRDD have a New Name

Franklin County Board of Mental Retardation and Developmental Disabilities is now the Franklin County Board of Developmental Disabilities. "We're the same agency," said Superintendent Jed Morison, explaining the effect of a new law signed by Gov. Ted Strickland on July 7th. "Only our name has changed."

With the enactment of Senate Bill 79, the words mental retardation were deleted from the name of the county boards serving persons with mental retardation and other developmental disabilities.

The agency's name is now Franklin County Board of Developmental Disabilities (FCBDD) instead of Franklin County Board of Mental Retardation and Developmental Disabilities (FCBMRDD).

Agency services and eligibility requirements are unchanged. Proponents of the name change argued that the use of mental retardation is offensive. Others countered that the term is medically and historically appropriate.

"Regardless of where we stood on this issue, we now need to come together to focus on serving our community," said Superintendent Morison.

County boards were created in 1967. They were then called county boards of mental retardation. The words developmental disabilities were added to the name in 1980 when the boards became responsible for serving persons with other developmental disabilities as well.

Senate Bill 79 was introduced by Senator Jimmy Stewart of Athens. The measure passed unanimously in both the House and Senate.

The bill deleted mental retardation also from the name of the Ohio Department of Mental Retardation and Developmental Disabilities.
