Old Business:

Discussion on having a ice cream social event for the opening of the pool Memorial day weekend. It was suggested that we have a “bring your own ice cream to share social” on the opening weekend (Saturday) at 1:00 p.m. Alan with talk with the HOA to confirm.

The committee would like to ask the HOA if two floor lamps could be purchased for the clubhouse. This would add to creating softer lighting during evening events.
