There's a lot of talk about crime problems in our area, but not a whole lot of citizen participation is there to do something about it.

Cellular on Patrol was started in this area in January, 1994. The original concept was neighbors carrying cell phones provided to them once they attended a two day class and report suspicious activity to the police department.


That concept is still the same. Attend two classes, carry your own cell phone, and be the extra eyes and ears

of the police in our neighborhood.

On June 10th & 17th at 6 PM, you can attend the next C.O.P class. They're free. Class length is about 3 to 4 hours on two Thursdays.

When submitting a suggestion, you will be asked to include the following information: Suggestion Title: This is the essence of your suggestion in as few words possible. as Suggestion **Description**: This is the "what" o f vour suggestion. It should reflect with as much detail as possible what you are suggesting be done.

Suggestion Purpose: This is the "why" of your suggestion. It should explain with as much detail as possible the reason for implementing the

Water rates for San Antonio Water System customers (SAWS) are due for a change. City Council is scheduled to vote on the rate request June 17th

Valentine Ruiz, information spokesperson for SAWS, told members of the JNA at our May meeting that water rates could go down a few cents for customers who continue conserve to water.

He used a power point presentation to show how the new rates will affect vour water bill.
