
### Message from the President:

First, I would like to tell those of you who join CNNA year after year how much your membership means to our neighborhood. Out of over 600 residents in Canyon North, we average 120-150 Those paying members provide a much more members. appealing environment for all of us. ### **CNNA Membership Drive**

Our 8th year started on Oct. 1, 2009 and at this time we have about 121 members. When we regrouped the association in 2002, we had over 200 members that first year, so you can see that our membership has dropped off. Please remember that the CNNA is a **non-mandatory** association so we're not going to tell you what you can or can't do but we will try to help enforce City codes which means keeping fences fixed, houses painted and non functioning vehicles off the street. Our dues are only \$25 per year and it's well worth it when you get the benefits from local merchants whom we have negotiated with. We keep our perimeters mowed and many think that's a simple thing but keep in mind that if your house backs up to either Hefner Road or Rockwell then you own that piece of property on the other side of the fence and it's your responsibility to keep it mowed. Many people don't realize this so the association chose to pay to have it mowed so it would always look nice. The trees on that piece of property also belong to the homeowner and they should be kept trimmed, as the association simply can't afford to maintain them. The CNNA membership fee is a small price to pay to help your property retain value. Those who chose not to join also benefit from the Association, so why don't you do your part and join us. We need your support to help keep Canyon North a nice neighborhood.

## Spring Clean Up - THE BIG EVENT

This is an event that is sponsored by the University of Oklahoma every Spring. They provide students from the University to various neighborhoods throughout the metropolitan area to offer their services to help with the "clean-up" of the neighborhood. As many of you know, the perimeter of a neighborhood is the first thing that a potential new neighbor notices. So several of the Board members and other volunteers went with about 18 students to assist in cleaning up the perimeters of our neighborhood. It usually takes place during the Month of April, so keep this in mind next year if you wish to participate. Also, if you know of a particular project that we might want to tackle next year, please don't hesitate to let someone on the Board know.

### **CNNA Annual Garage Sale**

We had our annual Spring Garage Sale on April 23-25, this year. There were approximately 20 garage sales going on at that time and there appeared to be a lot of traffic throughout the neighborhood. Hopefully it was a good opportunity to let someone else enjoy all the things you wanted to get rid of. Another thing to keep in mind and take advantage of is Big Trash Day. It usually occurs the first week each month. The City provides an opportunity to get rid of all the items that won't fit into your big blues. Remember — every little thing that helps our neighborhood look neat, helps maintain our property values.
