# Fine increases for yard parking

Did you know that parking a vehicle on a lawn in Oklahoma City can now cost you \$100.00?

Effective July 1, the OKC City Council raised from \$10.00 the fine for parking any type of vehicle in a front, side or backyard.

Last year the OKC Action Center took more than 8,400 complaints about cars parked in yards. City code enforcers say that a vehicle parked in a yard is not only an eyesore, it can damage water and sewer lines and interfere with drainage.





# Permits needed for Alarm

Anyone who uses a security or fire alarm system at a home or business must have a City alarm permit. An upto-date alarm permit provides emergency personnel with current contact information, and allows you to list at least two people who can respond if they can't reach you. New permits are \$27.00 and annual renewals are \$17.00. Fines for not having a permit can exceed \$150.00. Download a permit application at www.okc.gov/alarm, or call 297-1109.

TotalCare provides you and permanent members of your household with emergency medical ambulance service through EMSA with no out-of-pocket expense. The program is just \$3.65 per month and can be added to your utility bill. More than 190,000 Oklahoma City households participate in TotalCare.
