SAISD Bond Vote in November

The San Antonio Independent School District (SAISD) Board of Trustees has called for a \$515 million bond election for November 2, 2010.

The funds would pay for renovations to schools across the district—where some buildings are more than 100 years old, and almost half are more than 50 years old.

The bond would address infrastructure repairs for a number of schools, as well as classroom additions and upgrades to meet current standards for instructional environments.

The bond would not have an effect on property taxes until 2012, when the average homeowner in SAISD would pay an additional \$1.58 a month. When bond payments peak in 2027, the average homeowner would see a tax impact of \$9.97 per month.

Early voting begins October 18th and runs through October 29th.
