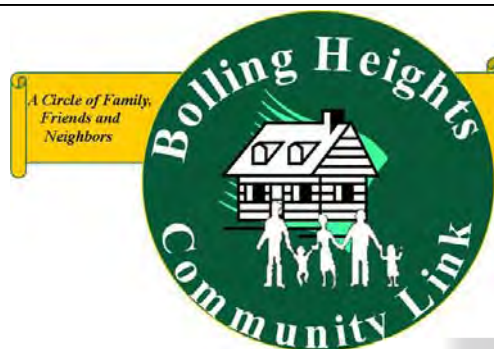

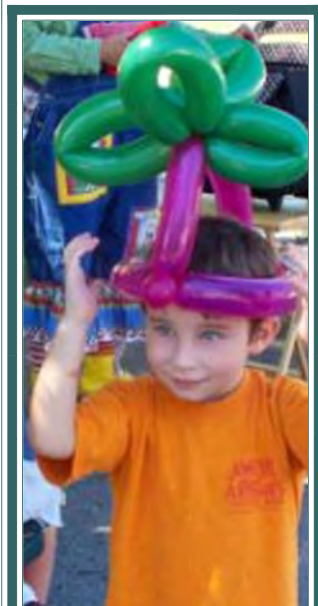
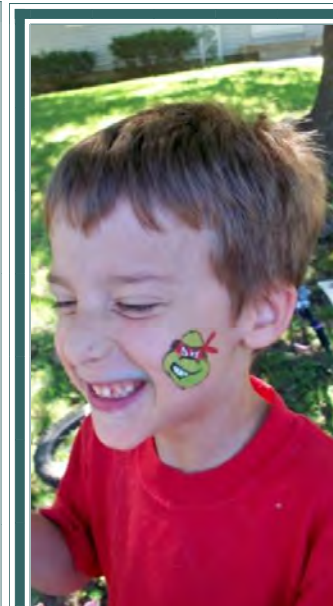

Traditional Pumpkin Bread**Ingredients:**

3 Cups Sugar	1 Cup Vegetable Oil
3 Eggs	2 Cups Pumpkin Puree (canned or home made)
1 Cup Walnuts	1/2 tsp. Salt
3 Cup Flour	1/2 tsp. Baking Powder
1/2 tsp Baking Powder	1 tsp. Baking Soda
1 tsp. Cloves	1 tsp. Cinnamon
1 tsp. Nutmeg	

Directions: Mix together oil, sugar and eggs, stir in pumpkin. Sift together dry ingredients in separate bowl and add to wet mixture. Stir in walnuts (optional). Pour into a greased bread pan. Bake at 350 degrees for 1 hour and 15 minutes. Test by sticking a toothpick or bamboo skewer in the center of the loaf. If it comes out dry, it's done. Allow to cool and serve slices with butter or honey-butter.
