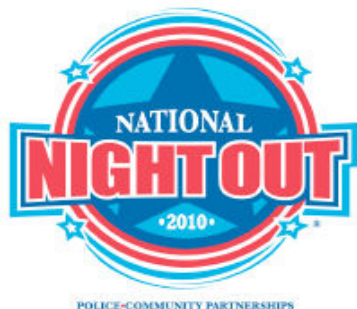
JNA Celebrates National Night Out - Texas Style

The money will be used for our scholarship program.

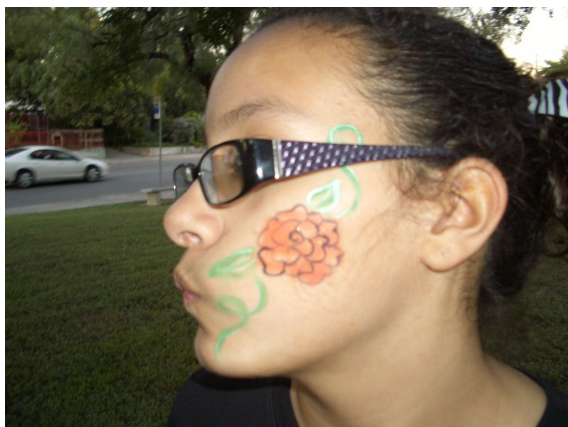

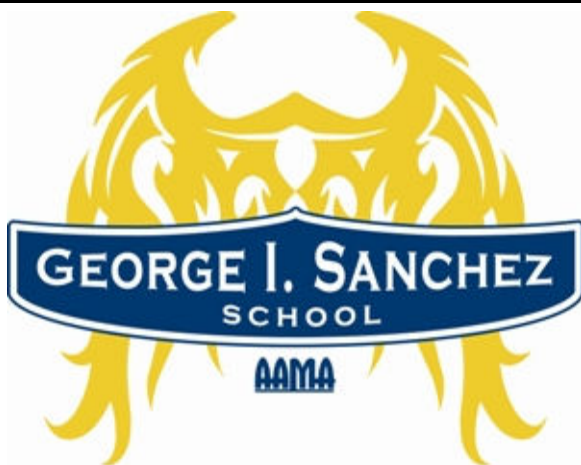
