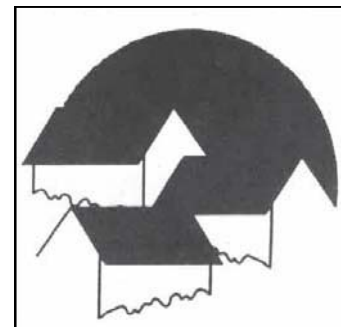

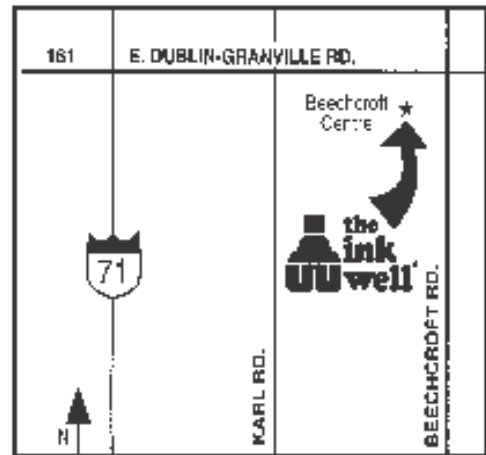

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TRY AND PREVENT THE OPPORTUNITY FROM HAPPENING!

"I'd rather be prepared for an opportunity that never comes than have an opportunity come and I am not prepared." - Whitney Moore Young. Opportunity, time, and concealment are the three main things that may make your home a target for burglars. Opportunity = opened or unlocked windows/doors or no vehicle in the driveway. Time = fixed routines or mid to late afternoon when most burglaries are committed. Concealment = overgrown landscaping, alleyways, or backdoors that allow access without being noticed. All of the above-mentioned areas should be considered, especially when it pertains to safety and crime within our community. What can you do to become prepared and improve home security?

1. **Lock and secure your windows, doors, and garage. It is best to do this even if you do not plan on being gone for a long period of time.**
2. **Do not hide a key outside your door.**
3. **Never call attention to expensive purchases. Placing empty boxes of recent purchases out for trash day can make you a target for a break in.**
4. **When you plan your next vacation, be sure you cancel any deliveries and have someone check on your house.**
5. **Consider installing motion sensor lights outside near entrances.**
6. **If you witness unusual activity within the community CALL THE POLICE, your neighbor or yourself maybe thankful you did.**
7. **If you have a security system always, arm it before you leave your home.**

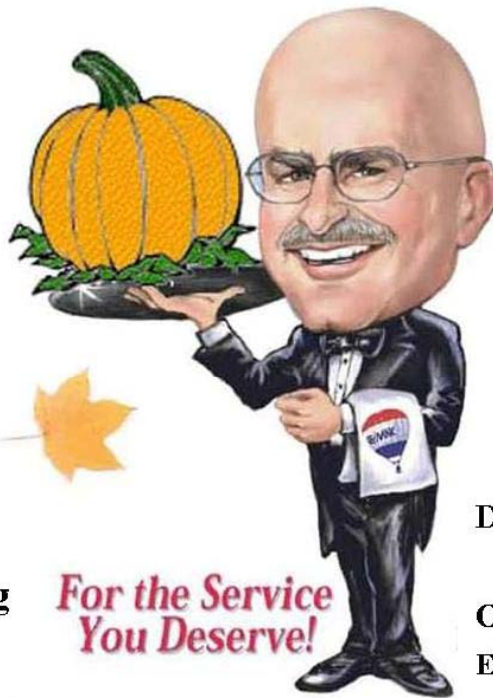


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
