How Fast is Too Fast?

Columbine West has a POSTED speed limit of 25 mph, except over the speed bumps and in the school zone. There has been (3) separate accidents in the development since August 15th, each of them in different areas, different times of day and different driving scenarios. The August incident was on Frost Dr. just west of the Webster/Frost Dr. intersection. Early in the morning, a vehicle driving at speeds estimated to be 60 mph, crashed into a Toyota 4Runner parked on the street, which pushed it over the sidewalk and into a neighboring yard and the speeding car ended up across the street in yet another yard. The next accident was a few days later, not far from the corner of Webster/Frost Dr. again. This time it was just South of the intersection, where a truck swerved across the street and landed in front of a blue spruce. The last reported incident was on W. Portland Ave. where the "S" curve is. Around 10:30 p.m., neighbors were continued on page 2

rustled out of their homes by the sounds of an F-150, double cab, losing control, running up onto the sidewalks and flipping a 180 degree turn before finally stopping. In each of these accidents, not a single person was seriously injured, but certainly nerves of neighbors were rattled. At the October CWCA meeting, neighbors talked about the accidents and tried to make sense of why such accidents are occurring on our streets. Each of the incidents had two things in common, the Sheriff's report noted, excessive speed and careless driving. The issue of adding more speeds bumps was discussed, but the County is now requiring homeowners to help defray the cost. Additional signage was also addressed. As we enter into the Winter months where driving conditions can deteriorate quickly, can we all take a moment before we slip behind the wheel to remember how quickly a distracted driver can impact lives of others?

The McCombs Family has lived in Columbine West since 1994, when the family was transferred from San Diego's General Dynamics and merged with Martin Marrieta. The front entrance to the house was a small non-descript concrete sidewalk encroached by spiky junipers. The front door was an odd double door that begged to be replaced. A new installation of a single door, flanked by half glass side panels, brings more light into the entryway and updates the entrance. In an effort to capture more outdoor living space, they had a large trex deck built by TK Quality Construction added onto the front. The driveway was also lined with small evergreens that began to overtake the area. Tearing them out with the help of a braided tow rope and a Toyota 4Runner, made way for flagstone to be



Home Security Checklist

- Trim all trees up from the ground by 5-6 feet.
- Trim bushes and shrubs down below all windows.
- Install motion detection lighting in the front and back.
- Use a "Charlie Bar" to secure your rear sliding glass door.
- Secure gates leading to your back yard.
- Ensure garage doors are closed and locked.
- Lock door between garage and house.
- Remove any home or vehicle keys from garage.
- Close blinds and/or shades.
- Replace short door strike plate screws w/ longer ones (3" or 3.5").
