Greater Des Moines Habitat for Humanity provides simple, affordable housing through building and renovation. Through work, I have helped for a number of years. I am interested in getting a group of up to 12 people from our neighborhood to volunteer someday this fall. Contact Brenda Peel bkpcats@juno.com or 515-249-2285 to let me know if you are interested. We could choose a Saturday and help for either a half or full day. They also need help during the week if that would be better for people. Habitat provides tools and will train you on whatever you need to do that day. If possible, bringing a few of your own basic tools such as a hammer, screwdriver, gloves, etc. is helpful. Things I have helped do in the past are paint, hang siding, waterproof a basement and install a staircase. Information on Habitat can be found at www.gdmhabitat.org or (515)471-8686. Habitat also has a **Restore** where you can donate products left over from your project or buy products that have been donated. This is a good place to find paint, screws, doors, and I've even seen a full kitchen worth of counter tops. Please consider them when shopping for your project.
