sponsors such as Target, Cash America Pawn, CPS Energy and many others were instrumental in the success of this year's event.

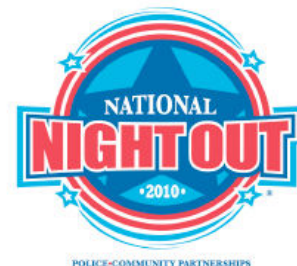
National Night Out, sponsored by the NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF TOWN WATCH, is a neighborhood crime and drug prevention event that occurs annually on the first Tuesday in August (IN TEXAS NNO 2010 IS IN OCTOBER) and is celebrated in every city, town and village in the US.

In addition to increasing awareness of crime and drug prevention programs, NNO also strengthens

neighborhood spirit and community-police partnerships, while sending a message to criminals that "neighborhoods are organized and fighting back against crime!"

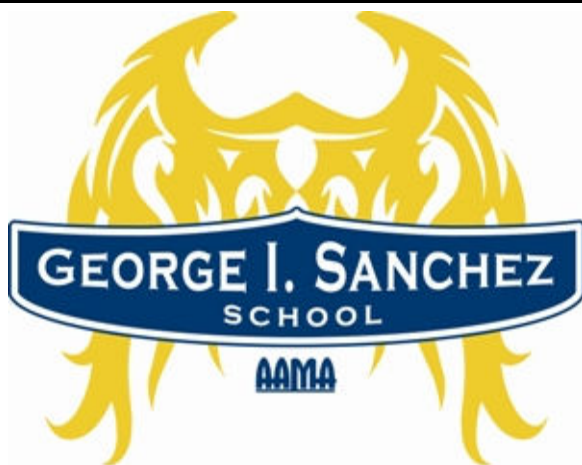

Changes being made to Brush & Bulky Pickup Collections

In an attempt to increase recycling efforts in the city, changes are being made to the brush and bulky collections schedule as we know it now.

Starting in February, the brush collection will be separated from the bulky collection. You won't be able to put your old furniture out with the brush pickup under the new plan.

Bulky items will only be picked up **once a year**. The schedule will be different for both pickups.

Please start telling your neighbors not to put their unwanted bulky items on the

curb where they will sit for a year. Code Compliance will be monitoring this situation.

There will continue to be two brush pickups per year.

According to city law, your house address **MUST** be visible from the street. That means the numbers should be at least 4" tall and posted where they can be read by emergency crews or police.

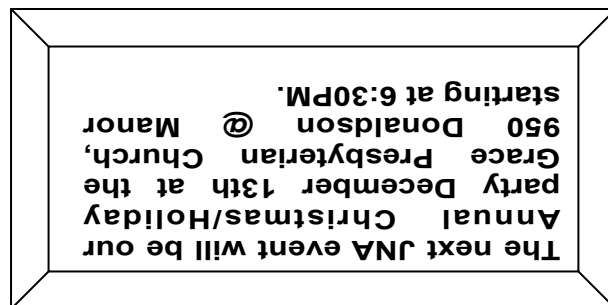
