Results of 2010 Community Survey Released

Residents' opinions are a valuable part of the City of San Antonio's decision-making processes. The Community Survey serves as a vehicle of communication and reinforces t h e relationship between the City and our residents.

In April 2010, the conducted second city-wide survey identify residents' satisfaction with the delivery of major City services and to help determine priorities for community. The results from the survey revealed areas where the city excels in services and those that need improving.

The major services

that residents felt were most important for the City to provide were police safety services, streets and infrastructure maintenance, and fire and emergency medical services.

The major City services that scored the highest overall levels of satisfaction were: fire and emergency medical services (87 percent satisfied or very satisfied), public library services (85 percent satisfied or very satisfied), solid waste services percent (78 satisfied or verv satisfied) and 3-1-1 customer service (78 percent satisfied or very satisfied).

According to survey results, compared to other large cities. San Antonio ranks above average in almost everv category service surveyed.

most improved since overall quality of City services rated 18 percent above the national average. (San Antonio was compared to results easy" to use (16 percent of a survey conducted by resident ETC Institute in April 2010 of U.S. cities with populations of 250,000 or more).

The overall survey percent results for San Antonio increased significantly satisfaction with the while the results for most other communities decreased significantly.

Collection of **FY 2010-2011** dues has begun. If your mailing label has a "pd" symbol by your name, you're paid up for the new fiscal year.


