🧽 Please, be respectful...

The Farley board has received complaints of loud noises waking and/or keeping residents awake. These noises have come from barking dogs, revving vehicle motors, kids playing in the streets late at night, and fireworks. Please remember not everyone is on the same schedule and some residents retire early and others rise late. Please be mindful of this and try to keep noise to a minimum whenever possible so everyone's sleep patterns can be accommodated.

It's time for the Farley Neighborhood Association annual dues...

It is vitally important for all residents to support our neighborhood by remitting your **\$20 per household annual dues** promptly. The dues are used to help with the following:

- Street maintenance
- Street speed control
- Storm water drainage
- Sewer service and rates
- Zoning controls

- Code enforcement
- Crime Watch programs
- Spring and Fall Garage Sale advertising, signs, and press releases
- Snow removal at 3-4" of accumulation*

Do you know where your kids are...

The **Curfew Law** states that youths may not be in public places as follows:

Under 15: Not after 11 PM or before 5 AM, all days. **15 – 17 years old:** Fridays and Saturdays, not after 1 AM or before 5 AM; Sunday through Thursday, not after 11 PM or before 5 AM.

Exceptions:

- When involved in church or school activities.
- When accompanied by a parent or guardian
- Going to or returning from a job

If you observe violations of the curfew law, **call 911** to report them.

Attempted home invasion...

There was a home invasion attempt on West 15th Street recently. A neighbor noticed a red Neon backed into a driveway and heard a loud banging noise. He discovered two strangers at the neighbor's back door. When he asked what they were doing, they quickly left.

Police found they had tried to kick in and then use a crow bar to pry open the door. The police said there were a few other homes in this neighborhood that have made similar reports.

The men are described as a black male about 6 ft tall and about 300 lbs. The other man was a smaller black male. They were driving a red Neon.
