Featured Recipe:

CHOCOLATE-DIPPED STRAWBERRIES

Ingredients

- 1/2 cup semisweet chocolate chips
- 3 tablespoons heavy cream
- 12 long-stemmed strawberries

Melt the chocolate and cream together in a bowl set over simmering water until just melted. Stir and remove from the heat. Dip each strawberry in the chocolate and set aside on waxed or parchment paper to dry.

Energy Audit Program

Another program involves a trained professional coming to your home to seal the leaks in your air conditioning ductwork to help you lower your overall energy consumption. The cost is \$50 and includes the replacement of duct vent if needed (up to 15 feet).
