

City Council District 10 2011 College Scholarship Program

The District 10 College Scholarship Program is open to all high school seniors that live in Council District 10 and are planning to attend a two-year or four-year college or university beginning in the Fall 2011 semester. Each applicant is required to submit a scholarship package containing an application, essay, official high school transcript and two letters of recommendation.

To be eligible an applicant must:

- 1. Be a resident of District 10
- 2. Be a 2011 graduating high school senior
- 3. Provide official high school transcript of academic achievement
- 4. Be active in community service activities
- 5. Anticipate college attendance in Fall 2011
- 6. Have / apply for a library card
- 7. Submit a completed application and scholarship packet

The District 10 Scholarship Selection Committee will select ten (10) seniors from District 10 to receive the award. Winning students will be required to submit proof of college acceptance for the Fall 2011 semester. Proof may consist of registration documents and/or letter of acceptance. The selected students will receive a MacBook laptop, software and accessories valued at about \$2000.

Northern Hills Golf Course re-zoned using the new "G" designation

On Thursday, January 20, 2011, the city council voted to rezone the Northern Hills Golf Course from MF-33, a multi-family zoning, to the new Golf Zoning District. This new zoning district will preserve the existing golf course and green space.

This effort began in January 2008 after the Northern Hills Home Owners Association made their formal zoning request to the City Council. The District 10 office worked with city staff to create the new Golf Zoning District designation for all golf courses and open spaces. The vote was the completion of the rezoning process, which began with a city council resolution in October 2010.

"This was a great community lead effort to preserve the integrity and quality of life of the Northern Hills area which consists of 1,700 homes and over 4,000 residents", said Councilman Clamp. "We are happy that the council voted unanimously to rezone the golf course to prevent multi-family developments within their neighborhood. I would like to thank my colleagues, city staff and the community for their support of this effort."

Collection of Leaves

Residential Solid Waste customers may request two (2) free of charge collections for grass clippings and leaves per fiscal year. Additional collections within the same fiscal year may be requested but are subject to a fee. The city will only pick up grass clippings and leaves placed in either paper bags or cardboard boxes and must meet the following specifications:

Paper Bags

- total material not to exceed eight (8) cubic yards
- not to exceed fifty (50) bags
- individual bag must not weigh more than forty (40) pounds
- must be of two-ply kraft (lawn and leaf paper bags)
- must have a wet strength of forty (40) pounds
- must be securely closed
- must be resistant to breakage when lifted



Acceptable Pile

Paper bags can be purchased from local retailers (i.e., Lowes, Home Depot, Target, and HEB*).

Cardboard Boxes

- total material not to exceed eight (8) cubic yards
- not to exceed fifty (50) boxes
- individual box must not weigh more than forty (40) pounds
- · not to exceed four (4) feet in height or width
- must be made of brown bio-degradable cardboard
- must be securely closed
- must be resistant to breakage when lifted
- size of box must allow for easy lifting and handling by one (1) person

Letter (Email) to the Editor:

The February article "My dog is an angel WITH HORNS" was written anonymously, but probably applicable to more than one would initially think. I sincerely hope that the readers who it applies to take note. My neighbor has a dog that is outside 99% of the time (was fortunately taken inside during the recent lengthy freezing temperatures). The only way I know it was taken inside during that bad weather stint was because there was a lapse in the barking. As indicated in the article, I am one who cannot enjoy being outside in my yard, because I have to take refuge indoors to try to block out the barking. neighbor's dog has been a problem for a long time, but recently I noticed he has competition. I have started working from home part time and have learned there is a dog about a block away that can bark for hours on end and obviously loud enough to be heard by many. As I sit at my home office desk trying to concentrate or lead phone calls with peers, I can hear the hound's nonstop howling (with all windows closed and heater on) and it is very disturbing. do not blame the dogs, it is the owners lack of training and consideration for both their dog and others that causes the problems for the neighborhood. appreciate the article being published so attention can be brought to the situation.



Property Owner Sidewalk Maintenance Responsibility

Many Citizens assume that the City has the obligation to maintain all community sidewalks to keep them free from hazard and obstruction! However, City Ordinances require sidewalks to be maintained by property owners as an extension of their front yards.

This includes:

- Minimum sidewalk clear-width of 36" free "from any defects or hazards" or obstructions such as mailboxes, basketball hoops, parked cars, trash cans, shrubbery or fences. (Code of Ordinances, City of San Antonio, Chapter 29, Article 1, Sec. 29-11)
- Minimum clear-height of 80", "keep all trees and shrubs on the premises well trimmed so they will not overhang the sidewalks or streets in such a manner as to interfere with free passage." (Code of Ordinances, City of San Antonio, Chapter 29, Article 1, Sec. 29-10)
- Maintain a smooth sidewalk rolling surface free "from any defects or hazards" such as large cracks, broken or uplifted sidewalk segments. (Code of Ordinances, City of San Antonio, Chapter 29, Article 1, Sec. 29-11)
- ◆ Citation and Fine of up to \$500.00 (Ordinance #96242)




