
Who is NEW?

A message from N.E.W. President Cynthia Vignos...

I am pleased to announce that the N.E.W. Neighborhood Association has been

awarded a grant for \$2654.00! This money was made available through the Neighborhood Partnership Grant Program which receives funding from CHASE, the City of Canton, The Repository and the Stark Community Foundation.

This grant application was written for the development and beautification of the vacant lot on Cromer Avenue NW into a Canton Police Officers Memorial Park, to honor those safety officers who have lost their lives while protecting our citizens.

The proposal includes installation of benches, trash cans, landscaping and a graveled parking area. This project will improve the SARTA bus-stop area and provide a recreation area within our neighborhood's boundaries. The grant money will also be used for printing, postage, meeting expenses and other administrative costs.

The N.E.W. Neighborhood Association encourages everyone to get involved, and help make our community a better place. We cannot succeed without people willing to volunteer their time and talent. How can you help?


