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# New House Bill Approved for Property Tax Valuation

The new Georgia House bill that allows property tax valuation to be based on the last arms length transaction is now in effect, starting January 1,2011. While this is of great benefit to home buyers, it will have a negative effect on the value of homes by existing homeowners. In light of this change in the law, now more than ever is the need for every homeowner to apply for a tax appeal from their county for the re-valuation of their homes. If the value of our homes are going to be decreased, then certainly the taxes we pay should be equal to that value. The burden is on the property owner to make the appeal and prove their value. This has been a harsh winter with unexpected deep freezes which has gotten many of us thinking about things that could possibly occur to our property that could be a major headache for a property owner. One major problem that can occur that could cost you serious money is bursting pipes. **Bursting pipes** occur when frozen water causes a pressure buildup between the ice blockage and the

closed faucet. Pipes in attics, crawl spaces and outside walls are particularly vulnerable to extreme cold. To keep water in your pipes from freezing:

- Fit exposed pipes with insulation sleeves or wrapping to slow heat transfer.
- Seal cracks and holes in outside walls and foundations near water pipes with caulking.
- Keep cabinet doors open to allow warm air to circulate around pipes.
- Keep a slow trickle of water flowing through faucets connected to pipes that run through an unheated or unprotected space.
