9. Call Linda if you can help make September a great month at the El Dorado pool.

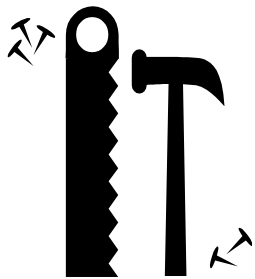

El Dorado Exemplary Homes Campaign 2011, Part One

About the Exemplary Homes Campaign

The Exemplary Homes Campaign is a way to recognize and thank those residents who help make El Dorado a nice place to live through payment of their annual association maintenance fees and by keeping a well maintained home and property.

The guidelines for participation in the event are pretty simple: just pay your annual association maintenance fees and keep up your property's curb appeal by having nice landscaping and high maintenance standards.

The campaign is divided into two phases, where 30 exemplary homes are chosen in May and 30 more are chosen in August. Since many residents don't pay their annual maintenance fees until summer, when the pool opens, May's winners are limited to those residents who paid their maintenance fees in 2010 and August's winners are limited to those who paid their fees in 2011.

To determine which homes are awarded Exemplary Home status, the six neighborhood association area reps nominated 8 to 10 homes in each of their respective areas. Then an independent panel of judges, who do not live in El Dorado and who do not know last year's winners, scored the nominees. The scores were then averaged and the 5 homes with the highest scores in each area were given the title of Exemplary Home.

The winners receive a temporary yard sign announcing their status as an Exemplary Home and also an invitation to the Exemplary Homes Party on Saturday September 17, from 6 to 8pm at the neighborhood clubhouse. At the party, food and beverages will be served and all winners will have a shot at winning fabulous door prizes which were generously donated by the event's sponsors listed on the opposite page.

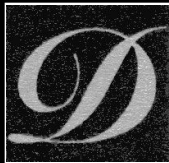

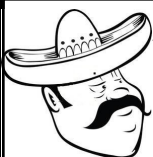
