Tidbits

Voters are being asked to fund over \$596 Million in improvements city wide on May 12, 2012. Early voting begins April 30th.

Streets in our area will be improved. W. Huisache from Zarzamora to Kampmann and W. Mistletoe from San Antonio Zarzamora will reconstructed and receive new curbs and sidewalks. Magnolia from Lake to Zarzamora will get new curbs, sidewalks, and pedestrian Wilson from enhancements. Club to Donaldson will get a new sidewalk and curb on the west side, plus a center median. Thespian island at Kampmann and Donaldson will intersection improvements.

Woodlawn Lake Park will receive \$1 million for development, improvement, and rehabilitation of basic park infrastructure

It was later determined due to the Seeling Channel Improvements that the Pedestrian Bridge Project would be handled through CIMS Horizontal.

The Engineering Firm engaged by CIMS Horizontal is AECOM. TBG Partners was one of their Landscape Architectural Design Consultants. This provided continuity between Pre-design and then ultimately design of the Pedestrian Bridge in conjunction with the Seeling C h a n n e 1 Improvements.)


