The bulk of the revenue from dues is used for maintaining the common areas (mowing the greenbelts, planting flowers at the entrances, sprinkler repairs, etc.), providing the security service, and future snow plowing/removal. ### Greenbelts for Pedestrian Use Only!

Parents, please remind your teenagers that our neighborhood greenbelts are for the enjoyment of all our residents, but they are for pedestrian use only! Unauthorized vehicles (motorcycles, four wheelers, etc.) are not permitted at any time. We have had some recent activities that are infractions to these rules. Running motorcycles and four wheelers through these areas at high speeds after dark is especially dangerous. Please make sure your children are aware of these rules.
