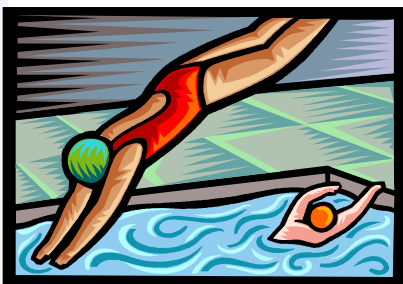
- ◆ Please review and return your covenant proxy as soon as possible so information may be added to City electronic data base.
