*City Ordinance 16-291 - 16-320

*Each residence is allowed 4 garage sales per calendar year not to exceed on garage sale per quarter.

*One permit is required for each garage sale.

*Signs cannot exceed 4 square feet each.

Thanks to those of you who've said you will serve.


Officers will be sworn in officially at our September 10th meeting.

This includes \$5.9 million in funding for public art projects within the following propositions: Streets, Bridges and Sidewalk Improvements, Drainage and Flood Control Improvements, Parks and Recreation and Open Space Improvements, Library Museums and Cultural Arts Facilities, and Public Safety Facility Improvements.
