Call to Order

WLH Recipe of the Month

Sopapilla Cheese Cake

from the Kitchen of Sheila and Ray Camp

Ingredients

2 (8 Ounces) cream cheese

2 Cups sugar (divided)

1 tablespoon vanilla

2 tubes frozen crescent rolls

1 stick butter

Cinnamon (see below)



1. Heat oven to 350 degrees
2. Put cream cheese, 1/1/2 cups sugar and vanilla in to mixing bowl .Mix till creamy (About 2 mins)
3. In a 13x9 dish -Layer 1 can crescent rolls. Pour cheese mixture over this. Then top with the second package.
4. Melt the stick of butter in the microwave and pour over the dish
5. In a small bowl mix the 1/2 cup of sugar and 10 shakes of cinnamon. Pour over the top of the dish .
6. Bake in the oven for 30 minutes until the top is browned

Optional:

Melt about 1/4 to 1/2 cup honey- pour over the top of the dish while still warm then sprinkle more sugar /cinnamon mix.




Henry G. Plance (1924-2012)

Henry G. Plance passed away, Saturday February 20, 2012. There was a Memorial Service for Henry on March 3rd, 2012 at St. Luke's in the Meadow Episcopal Church. A reception followed the Memorial Service. If you would like to remember Henry, you may make a donation to St. Luke's in the Meadow Episcopal Church. Henry was born May 17th, 1924 in Canton, Ohio. He married Julia "Judy" Sauer on March 29th, 1948. He retired from Safeway Corporation in 1987. Henry loved to play golf with his buddies and was known for his dry sense of humor. Henry was a member of St. Luke's in the Meadow Episcopal Church and was a 32nd-degree Mason. Henry was a longtime member of COPS. Henry and Julia always patrolled the neighborhood together. Henry is survived by his wife Julia. They were married for 63 years. Henry and Julia had one son, Daniel. Henry is survived by Julia, Daniel, one sister, two nieces and six nephews.

LaMonte A. Tucker (1910-2012)

LaMonte A. Tucker, 101, retired U.S. [Army](#) colonel, passed away Wednesday, March 28, 2012. Funeral: 1:30 p.m. Monday at Mount Olivet Funeral Home. Interment: Mount Olivet Cemetery. Visitation: 4 to 6 p.m. Sunday at Mount Olivet Funeral Home. Col. Tucker was born May 4, 1910, in Denver, Colo., to Percy and Aline Tucker. He married his lifelong sweetheart, Mary Haslett, on Nov. 23, 1935. After graduating from TCU, he went on to study for his master's degrees at the [University of Texas](#). After the attack on Pearl Harbor, he enlisted in the Army in early 1942. He served with a medical unit in Europe and Japan. At the close of the war, he treated the injured in Japan. Upon returning to the states, he completed a Ph.D. in bacteriology at the University of Wisconsin. He was an original member of the Army Chemical Corps, which was formed after World War II. Col. Tucker served around the world with several stops at Fort Detrick, Md. He was offered a promotion to general, but chose to retire. He retired from the Army in August 1965 as deputy director of special weapons development at Edgewood Arsenal, Baltimore, Md. Upon retirement, he was awarded the Legion of Merit medal. Later, he operated Terrell Labs in Fort Worth and his own cytotoxic lab. He was preceded in death by his wife, Mary, on April 12 1991. Survivors: Son, Monty and wife, Ruth; grandson, John and wife, Olivia; granddaughter, Elizabeth Scott and husband, Jeff; grandson, Steve Henderson and wife, Dee; great-grandchildren, Julia, Victoria and Trent Tucker, Alex and Garrett Scott, Steven and Justin Henderson; brother, Chester Tucker and wife, Nancy; many nieces and nephews; and a host of friends.


