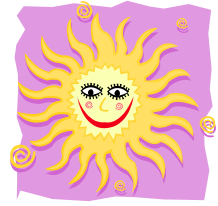

mosquitoes at what seems to be an all-time high, steps must be taken to protect yourself and your family. The Texas Department of State Health Services suggests the following as your best defense against infection:

- ✓ Use repellent containing DEET, picaridin or oil of eucalyptus.
- ✓ Dress in long sleeves and pants while outside.
- ✓ Stay indoors at dusk and dawn when mosquitoes are most active.
- ✓ Drain standing water where mosquitoes breed i.e. tires, flowerpots, birdbaths and clogged rain gutters

Did You Know?

There are 73 Code Enforcement Officers assigned to seven Field Enforcement Units.

Each Unit provides inspection and enforcement services across the city. These units respond to complaints received from citizens, the City's 311 system, and on a proactive basis.

Denise Hastings is the Supervisor of the Northwest District, which includes the Jefferson area. (210) 416 - 5851.

The Neighborhood Enhancement Team (NET) is a newly created team of proactive code enforcement officers dedicated to coordinated code investigations and special projects with special emphasis on highly traveled areas throughout the City's main district corridors and inner city reinvestment areas.

Traffic along Woodlawn continues to be disrupted.

Motorists will see detour signs posted along Wilson near Woodlawn.

For the next month, Woodlawn will be closed along Wilson to Lake and from Huisache to French.

The construction is part of the drainage project along Woodlawn Lake.

Motorists are advised to take alternate routes.

Construction is expected to last through October 6th.

No Go On Green Carts_yet

A north side city councilman has put a red stop sign on the green recycling carts that were supposed to be launched in our area.

District 10 Councilman **Carlton Soules** requested, and got, the 2013 budget item pulled from council consideration.

Soules says he doesn't like the idea of going into the expense

of another cart for organic waste pickup.

The city would like to have a 60% recycling rate by year 2020.

A "Pay as you Throw" rate scheme is in the recycling plan, too.

78228 Post Office Closing

According to a letter given to all Post Office Box holders at the University Post Office (78228), located on Bandera Road, the facility will be closing Sunday, October 7, 2012.

All post office boxes and window services will be moved to the Beacon Hill Station, located at 1064 Vance Jackson.

The loss of their lease is the reason being given for the closure.

Wal Mart will be constructing a shopping plaza in the area and is expected to use the PO site for their outlets.

Officer Dispenses Advice on Safety

Automobile burglaries in our area are still high according to San Antonio Fear Free Environment (SAFFE) officer **Marcos Cerda**.

Cerda says to be sure and remove your keys and lock your vehicle.

He also says graffiti is on the decline because of stricter enforcement.

Cerda emphasized the need to watch your neighbor's property and call 9-1-1 if you see suspicious activity.
