### A Note About Yorkshire Downs Condominium Neighborhood:

Your community has a homeowners' association (HOA). It consists of all of the property owners within the 120 unit complex which has common and individual interests. All deed owners of the units are members of the HOA. All renters or lessees of the property must comply with the rules set forth by the HOA.

The Community Group Management Company and the Board of Directors duties include (but not limited to):

- Enforcing provisions of the declaration, articles, bylaws and standing rules for the ownership and management of the development
- Paying taxes and assessments that are, or could become, a lien on the common area
- Contracting insurance on behalf of the association
- Contracting for goods or services for the common areas or for the association
- Delegating its powers to any committees, officers or employees of the association authorized by the governing documents
- Preparing budgets and financial statements for the association
- Formulating rules of operation for the common areas and facilities
- Conducting disciplinary proceedings against members of the association for violations of the rules
