Keeping sidewalks free from any defects and hazards or obstructions such as mailboxes, basketball hoops, parked cars, trash cans, shrubbery or fences. (Code of Ordinances, City of San Antonio, Sec. 29-11, and Sec. 6-1) Citation and Fine of up to \$500.00 (Sec. 1-5)

Keeping all trees and shrubs on the premises well trimmed so they will not overhang the sidewalks or streets in such a manner as to interfere with free passage. (Code of Ordinances, City of San Antonio, Sec. 29-10)




CITY CODE VIOLATIONS

Major developers of the subdivision were

Shephard & Burris and Morton/Southwest.

When the subdivision first started, it was outside the city limits.

Cattle Grazed in bluebonnet fields. Seven windmills operated in the confines of El Dorado, and the lake was actually a cow pond.

A local dairy made home delivery, and deer were everywhere.

Perrin Beitel and Nacogdoches were two lane roads. The nearest place to buy

Groceries was a Piggly Wiggly at Nacogdoches at Loop 410.

There were no restaurants in the area, and the Tower of the Americas could be seen from the subdivision.
