We are excited about the New Year and all that it has in store!







Yellow cake mix (and ingredients required to bake)

Small can pineapple tidbits with juice

Instant vanilla pudding mix

1/2 cup milk

8oz Cool Whip

Coconut (optional)

- 1. Bake cake as directed in rectangular baking pan
- 2. While cake is still hot, top with undrained pineapple tidbits.
- 3. Allow cake to cool.
- 4. Mix mild and pudding mix well. Fold in Cool Whip.
- 5. Use pudding/Cool Whip mixture to frost cake.
- 6. Top with coconut, if desired.
