September Meeting Recap

As the last neighborhood meeting upcoming dates for a special waste collection, the 15 year Anniversary and concerns about cars parked on the street on 124th near Mill Plain were shared. The city was notified that the holes in the covering over the water tower were allowing sand to escape during blasting, affecting the homes nearby.

Ed Kawasaki of Additional Storage shared info on the storage facilities and an offer to support various FNA activities as well as a free storage space for FNA signs and other property. The members present at the meeting voted to offer advertising space on their website to Additional Storage as a thank you.

An ongoing discussion at our recent meetings has been the invasive ivy, weeds and trash accumulating on east 9th St. An estimate was received to have it cleaned up for \$1940. The Pinebrook Homeowners Association agreed to pay half of this cost. A motion that the FNA pay the other half failed to pass at the last meeting and a renewed effort to gather volunteers to do the clean up was started. 
