# Westridge Elementary Kindergarten & New Student Registration For The 2012-2013 School Year

**Kindergarten registration:** Students must be age 5 by October 1, 2012 to be eligible for admission. Please register your student online by visiting the Jeffco Connect website: https://jeffcoconnect.jeffco.k12.co.us/. (If you already have a Jeffco Connect account, use your current user name and password to log on. If you do not have a Jeffco Connect account, click on the yellow button ("New to Jeffco Public Schools?") and follow the instructions to create your account.) Once you have logged in, please enter all of the information required to create a record for your kindergartner.

After you have created your kindergartner's or new student's record, submit the following items to the school office: Your student's birth certificate; your student's record of immunizations, including evidence of Hepatitis B shots; and proof of your current address (for example, a utility bill or lease agreement).

For kindergarten, please indicate your preference for our morning session ("KA") (8:25 a.m.-11:00 a.m.), our afternoon session ("KP") (12:30 p.m.-3:00 p.m.), or our full-day tuition-based session ("KG") (8:25 a.m.-3:00 p.m.). Tuition for the full-day program is expected to be \$300.00 per month but this is subject to change. Although we can usually honor your preference, we cannot guarantee placement in your preferred session.

Families not currently living in the Westridge neighborhood must also submit a Choice Enrollment application. Choice Enrollment applications may be picked up at Westridge Elementary or downloaded from http://jeffcoweb.jeffco.k12.co.us/enrollment/.

### Don't Let The Bedbugs Bite

There's a bloodsucking menace that strikes at night, is almost invisible, and is very difficult to kill. We're not talking about vampires, but bedbugs. Like vampires, bedbugs have plagued humanity for centuries - the ancient Greeks were complaining about them in 400 B.C. Bedbugs have flat, oval bodies about the size of apple seeds, which can make them hard to find. Although they were almost wiped out in the 1940s, they've enjoyed a resurgence in recent years, perhaps as a result of increased international travel – a survey by the National Pest Management Association says infestations jumped by as much as 30 percent in 2011. Bedbug bites are red, often with a darker spot in the middle. They itch like any other insect bite, and they're more likely to be found in a cluster or a ragged line. And they can produce a rash or an allergic reaction. Though the bites are annoying, they're not usually dangerous, although you may develop a secondary infection by scratching the bites (or, more rarely, suffer an anaphylactic or asthmatic reaction).

### Marriage: Still The Goal, Even As The Numbers Dwindle

In the 21st century, love and marriage still go together like a horse and carriage – and how many of those have you seen lately? A study by the Pew Research Center has found that marriage has slipped to an all-time low, with only 51 percent of adults living in wedded bliss (or at least legally joined), as compared with the high point of 72 percent in 1960.

Since 1960, the number of adults who have never been married has shot up from 15 percent to 28 percent. One possible reason: More people seem to be delaying marriage until they're older, possibly for financial reasons: The median age of people getting married for the first time has risen from 20.3 to 26.5 for women, and from 22.8 to 28.7 for men. But marriage doesn't seem to be on life support: 95 percent of under-30 singles told Pew that they wanted to get married at some point.

Saturday April 21, 2012. This will be the fifteenth year for this site. The 9HealthFair and Quest Diagnostics provide Blood testing at a reduced cost. Blood tests available include: Basic chemistry screening \$30.00, Prostate Specific Antigen (Men only) \$25.00, Hemoglobin A1C \$25.00, Blood count screening \$15.00, and Vitamin D \$40.00. Colon cancer screening kits are available for \$20.00.

All other screenings are free. Among the free screenings are vision, Height Weight and BMI, blood pressure, lung function. The sites are staffed totally by volunteers. Professional medical personnel, doctors, nurses, pharmacists, PTs, and phlebotomists all volunteer their time.
