WSSC Project Update at Lake Frank

Over the past few months, WSSC has been working on sewer line repairs at Lake Frank. Dan Hamilton, construction manager for the current project, reports that contractors began work repairing what they thought was going to be a single sewer line project. Since starting that project, inspection of adjacent pipes have also shown deterioration requiring additional work, he said, adding that some of these pipes are partially located under the lake.

Hamilton explained that crews are employing "trenchless technology" which uses a bypass pumping system with diverting pipeline to dry out the existing, aging pipes. This enables an epoxy type liner to be installed to rehabilitate the aging pipe preventing the disruption and cost of removal. Life expectancy of the new liner is roughly 50 years, he said.

The contractor, Inland Water, handling most of the work, is from Detroit and specializes in this type of repair. With the discovery of the additional deteriorating pipes, Hamilton puts the project's completion date at roughly the first of April.

Coming this Spring: The Manor Lake Garden Tour



Choosing a Deicer

We don't know if this winter will bring snow to our region yet, but freezing rain might prompt you to apply a deicer to your driveway, walks or steps. Do you know which one to apply with the least amount of damage to surfaces and to your plants?

Magnesium chloride and potassium chloride on old concrete will not damage those concrete and metal surfaces; they will harm plants moderately. Choose magnesium chloride for a very fast result or the potassium chloride if you can wait since it's slow acting.

Deicing products containing calcium chloride and sodium chloride though known to work fast and moderately fast respectively will harm concrete and damage plants. Neither should be applied to brick or stone surfaces.
