Household Hazardous Waste Collection Events

April 20, 2013 from 8 am – noon 2412 N. Center Street (Center St., north of McKellips Road) and

October 19, 2013 from 8 am – noon 6935 E. Decatur Street (Power Road, north of University Drive)

Southern Avenue Construction

(between Dobson and Alma School)

There will be improvements in the Fiesta District along Southern Avenue east of Dobson Road to Alma School Road. Construction is anticipated to begin April 2013 and last for approximately <u>one year</u>.

New Fiesta District Police Station

The new Fiesta District Police Station will replace the Dobson Substation, which was built in 1980 and no longer has the space or modern facilities required by Mesa PD. It will be a 2-story, 33,000 square foot building located at Grove and Westwood, near Alma School and Southern. It's completion date is set at September 2, 2013. Below is an artist's rendition.
