#### **NCC Police Update**

Officer Gladney reported at the January meeting. Below are some highlighted topics discussed:

- From 10/15/2012 to 1/14/2013 there were 24 calls to the police. Most calls were concerning thefts.
- Please remember to lock your house and car doors, close the doors on garages, and do not leave valuables in your car in plain sight.
- The state has a new law concerning solicitors. As of August 2012, solicitors must be able to present a permit to show where they work. You should ask to see their permit, if you are approached. If they fail to present a permit, you can report it to the police through the non-emergency phone number. Religious groups are not included.
- To look up reported fraudulent solicitors, check out <a href="https://www.ripoff.com">www.ripoff.com</a>.
- For neighbor or neighborhood disputes, the police have a unit to help mediate. Call the police nonemergency phone number for more information.
- For police activity in the area, check out www.citizenobserver.com.
- An additional website, to check out crimes that have occurred in our surrounding areas you can go to our website (www.neighborhoodlink.com/bear/whena) and click on New Castle County Police. On the right, click on "Crime Mapping" and follow the instructions from there. The crime mapping is updated every three months.

To report a crime or any suspicious behavior, contact the county police non-emergency number at 573-2800. If it is an emergency, call 911.

#### **New Castle County Code Awareness**

- Unregistered or inoperable motor vehicles are not permitted on your property unless in an enclosed structure.
- Vehicles are not permitted to park on unhardened surfaces such as grass or lawns of a residential property.
- Untitled/unregistered vehicles are not permitted to travel on public roads for any reason (motorcycles, scooters, go-karts, etc.).
- Grass and weeds are to be maintained to a height of eight inches or less.
- Pets must be on leashes and you must clean up your pet waste. Cats are not allowed to roam free.

To report a code violation, contact New Castle County Code Violations at 395-5555.
