#### **Deed Restrictions**

Horse riding in Gulf Meadows: On Labor Day, I was ingratiated by a gentleman riding a horse on the sidewalk in front of my house, with an unrestrained pit bull. As the man slowly rode past my home, the horse did his business here and there as he slowly trotted down the sidewalk with the dog wandering around. WHO DO YOU THINK CLEANED UP THAT MESS? Luckily, there was no incident. However, according to our Deed Restrictions, no livestock or poultry of any kind (horses, cows, sheep, goats, chickens, etc.) shall be raised, bred, or kept on any lot, except that dogs, cats or other household pets may be kept provided they are not kept, bred, or maintained for any commercial purpose. Also, no dog should run loose. ALL DOGS MUST BE ON A LEASH when leaving your property.

The risk of uncleanliness and disease factors that are found in farm animals is not worth the risk of disobeying deed restrictions when it involves our health.

I am asking all RESIDENTS to join in and contact the civic club if you know of any neighbor raising farm animals in their backyards. Your name will be kept confidential. Maintaining our CHARACTER in our neighborhood is most important. COME ON EVERYBODY! WORK WITH US!

# Spotlight on a Good Neighbor

Today our spotlight is on Lois McCauley, resident of Section 2 for 44 years. Although not always able to actively participate in the Civic Club, she always opens her home to the Nominating Committee for their meetings and those who collate the newsletter each month. She is one of the collators. Lois is always eager to help in any way she can. Thanks, Lois, for being a good neighbor.

## **Heavy Trash Program**

The Heavy Trash Program requires that you separate tree waste from other types of junk waste. The heavy trash schedule changes each month from tree waste to junk waste. Tree waste will not be picked up if you combine it with any type of junk waste. Junk waste is defined as furniture, appliances and other bulky material (lumber, fence material, etc.). Appliances containing refrigerant must have a tag attached to them certifying that a qualified technician has removed the refrigerant. These items should be placed adjacent to the front curb, easily accessible to the collection vehicle between the hours of 6:00 p.m. the Friday before and 7:00 a.m. on the scheduled collection day (4<sup>th</sup> Monday of each month). Heavy trash put out too early or mixed with Tree Waste/Junk Waste not picked up will be reported to 311 and you will be fined by the City of Houston. We need to keep our neighborhood clean.
