Did You Know?

All homeowners of the Park Olympia Subdivision are bound by certain Covenants and Restrictions(C&R's).

The following excerpts are just a few of the 35 C&R's which are listed in our "PO Declaration of Covenants and Restrictions":

#13. Animals: No sheep, goats, horses, cattle, swine, poultry, snakes, livestock, or other animals of any kind shall ever be raised, kept, bred, or harbored on any portion of the subdivision, except that dogs, cats, or other common household pets (not to exceed a total of three (3) adult animals).

#14. <u>Signs</u>: No signs or advertisements may be displayed on any lot except to advertise its sale. No more than one sign advertising a lot for sale shall be displayed on any one lot and such sign shall be no larger than five square feet (5').

#24. <u>Outside Parking and Storage of Vehicles, Etc.</u>: No trailer, tent, boat, recreational vehicle or stripped down, wrecked, junked, or wholly inoperable vehicle, equipment or machinery of any sort shall be kept, parked, stored, or maintained on any portion of the Lot.

Enjoy a greener lawn with thicker and deeper roots this summer by adding fertilizer to your lawn this spring. Be sure to buy the right type of lawn fertilizer for the type of grass (eg: St Augustine, Bermuda, etc.) that you have.

Lawn fertilizer is recommended to be applied during both the spring and fall seasons for best results and year round maintenance of your lawn.
