Need to Report a Green Pool?

This information is now on our website.

You go to http://www.maricopa.gov/EnvSvc/Complaints/Forms/ComplaintForm.aspx, and that opens a form that was a little confusing for me. Under Business Information you put the home address and for the Violation Information you put Green Pool. You don't have to put your name on the complaint.

Another option is to email the complaint to: webmail@mail.maricopa.gov. This one may be a bit easier and it is also on the website. It is really important as the weather gets warmer not to have mosquitoes breeding in these waters.



Mother Nature will be turning up the heat on us very soon, so now is a great time to take care of basic property maintenance.

- Remove all weeds and dried up vegetation. Property owners are responsible for maintaining their properties including the adjacent right-of-way (sidewalk, street, alley).
- Trim up any trees that hang over the sidewalk or street. Trees hanging over a sidewalk should allow a minimum of 8 feet, while trees hanging over a street should allow a minimum of 14 feet for safe passage.
- If you have a tree which sheds leaves or other droppings onto your neighbor's yard, get to know your neighbors and make sure that it is not causing a nuisance. Offer assistance to help dispose of the leaves or maintain the tree to prevent any unnecessary hardships.
- Move outside storage items into an enclosed building or screened area.
- Look around your yard and remove any items that may collect standing water to avoid breeding mosquitoes and other insects.
