Heavy Trash Program

The Heavy Trash Program requires that tree waste be bagged, separate from other types of trash and will not be picked up if included with other trash. Tree waste, if tied in bundles of 3-5 foot, will be picked up with bagged tree waste. Junk waste is furniture, appliances and other bulky material (lumber, fence material, etc.). Appliances containing refrigerant must have a tag attached to certify that a qualified technician has removed the refrigerant. Place the items close to the front curb, for easy access of the collection vehicle. Items may be placed the Friday before and by 7:00 a.m. on the scheduled collection day (4th Monday of each month). Heavy trash put out too early or mixed with Tree or Junk Waste will be reported to 311 and you will be fined by the City of Houston.
