#### **Deed Restrictions**

The Deed Restriction Committee would like to **Thank All Residents** who are working to keep our neighborhood a place where people want to live and raise their families.

- Keep grass cut in the backyard and get rid of junk. We have a serious rodent problem.
- Stop parking broken down cars and cars with expired tags on the street.
- Remove broken down cars from your driveway.

#### Shrubs Suffocating your House?

This is a common problem, shrubs can prevent window access, but they grow and can cause roof edge damage. Shrubs or plants too close to the house restrict airflow that plants and buildings need to prevent mold growth. Yard and trash waste accumulated above the cement foundation slab, provides easy access for termites and ants to enter through your weep holes or under siding.

## Grass, Weeds, Trash and Water

Mosquitoes breed where it is moist — tall grass, weeds, trash [anything that holds moisture], and water. Mow so that dew or rain water dries up quickly.

If you have standing water put cooking oil on the surface; a very small amount suffocates the mosquitoes.

If you have trash, GET RID OF IT as it breeds and attracts rats and other vermin.

## **Heavy Trash Program**

The Heavy Trash Program requires that tree waste be bagged, separate from other types of trash and will not be picked up if included with other trash. Tree limbs, **if tied in bundles of 3-5 feet,** will be picked up with bagged tree waste every Friday. Junk waste is furniture, appliances and other bulky material (lumber, fence material, etc.). Appliances containing refrigerant must have a tag attached to certify that a qualified technician has removed the refrigerant. Place the items close to the front curb, for easy access by the collection vehicle. Items may be placed the **Friday before**, and on the scheduled collection day (4th Monday of each month), by 7:00 a.m., as the trucks start collection very early.

Heavy trash pickup - tree trash mixed with junk [will not be picked up] but Junk [may be mixed with small tree trash]. Trash put out too early, will be reported to 311 and you will be fined by the City of Houston.

If unsure what or when to put out trash call 311.
