Do You Know Your Rights?

Being Hounded by Collection Agencies?

The Fair Debt Collection Act, Title 15. Commerce and Trade, Chapter 41. Consumer Credit Protection addresses your rights. Authorized Credit Card Users

If you are an authorized user on a primary credit cardholder's credit card, you are not responsible for paying the bill. This does not apply to joint account holders or co-signers. If you live in a com-

munity property state (like Texas), you may be responsible for debts incurred during your marriage.
