News From District 10

Dear District 10 Residents.

As we begin 2015 it is a good time to reflect on the events of last year in the district. At the top of my list is the ground-breaking and subsequent construction efforts for our new Northeast Senior Center. This wonderful facility, approved in the 2012 Bond Election, is set to open in the Fall of this year. Let's hope our weather doesn't slow down the process. In addition, we also successfully passed the hands-free ordinance that requires drivers to not hold onto their cell phones will driving.

Last year our neighborhoods did a great job in supporting a number of projects and events in District 10. Besides turning out for the groundbreaking ceremony for the Senior Center, residents attended Northeast Neighborhood Alliance meetings, Northeast Corridor (Nacogdoches and Perrin Beitel) Revitalization events, and National Night Out parties. Also, I personally want to thank our neighborhood leaders who testified before City Council in support of our Northeast Corridor Revitalization program as well as those who serve as members of our city's boards, commissions and committees, and everyone who stays involved in issues affecting our neighborhoods and City.

2015 will be a very busy year for City Council. Not only will we be preparing for elections in


May, we will also be voting on new police and fire department contracts, working on the 2016 budget priorities, monitoring current bond programs (streets, drainage, libraries, parks, etc.), and continuing efforts to improve the Northeast Corridor. My office will keep working to bring a Major League Soccer (MLS) team to San Antonio and have them play at Toyota Field, a prime location in our community.

As part of the May election, voters will be asked to approve some recommended changes to our City Charter. I have personally requested some of these changes because the current charter is in need of updates. Items will include how we fill vacancies for the Mayor, how we should vote on major programs like streetcars, possible City Council pay, and more. I will keep you informed on the various proposals now being studied by the City Charter Review Commission. Residents are encouraged to submit input on these amendments.

Beginning March 1, 2015, vehicles will no longer be issued an inspection sticker.


Your registration sticker will serve as a combined proof of registration and inspection.


Hello my El Dorado & Valencia Neighbors,
